- *Languedoc*, France A modern classic from the country heart of France, an understated wine, thirst quenching crisp acidity with pleasing resinous green fruits & a hint of savoury herbs. Perfect with seafood, sensational on its own.

Viognier, Reserve de Gassac, VdP de l'Herault 2010

- *Languedoc*, France The '2nd' wine of Daumas Gassac, often described as the first Grand Cru of the Languedoc. Notes of honeysuckle, apricot & peach, smooth in the mouth with pleasing waxy pear fruit, finishing fresh & clean.

Gavi "La Fornace", Cinzia Bergaglio 2010

- *Piedmonte*, Italy From the local Cortese grape which flourishes in the picturesque hills of Piedmonte. Fresh, floral and clean with a pleasing richness and a typical hint of toasted almonds. Perfect with flavoursome seafood.

Sauvignon Blanc, Petit Clos 2009

- *Marlborough*, NZ A Marlborough Sauvignon from internationally recognised Henri Bourgeois of Sancerre. Gentle tropical fruit aromas and capsicum notes and refreshing ripe currant, lemon and mandarin flavours in the mouth.

Chablis, Colette Gros 2009

- *Burgundy*, France A Chablis for lovers of great unoaked Chardonnay, trademark oyster shell aromas and gently honeyed on the palate, pleasing secondary fruit with an acidity that bolts all the flavours into position.

Sancerre, Henri Bourgeois 'Jeunes Vignes' 2009

- *Loire*, France Abundant characteristic Sauvignon aromas of gooseberry and elderflower, some grapefruit on the palate and firm crisp mineral freshness on the finish. Young vines, bright fruit – a great example of Sancerre

- *Languedoc*, France A delightful delicate rosé made from a blend of Southern French grapes (Syrah, Grenache and Cinsault) The sunshine of the area gives the wine body and texture but the joy is in the simple elegance. .

Cotes du Provence rosé, Carteron 'Elegance' 2010

- *Provence*, France From vineyards half hour's Ferrari ride from St. Tropez, the colour is the spirit of Provence. The nose is pretty, unveiling a floral bouquet with exotic and red berry fruits, the palate picks up notes of mango and lychee with a more savoury edge of cherry, peach-stone and citrus.

- <i>Central Valley</i> , Chile	Pleasant fruit driven aromas with just a hint of some peppery notes. In the mouth ripe red fruits are smooth, full of sweet rounded tannins that lead to a silky finish.

- <i>Languedoc</i> , France	Think New world fruit and classic French earth and herbs. Dark ruby-red, pleasant nose of violets, red and black fruits, hint of warm tar (classic Syrah note) and a gentle spicy finish.

- <i>Miapo</i> , Chile	An old Bordeaux grape re-discovered & re-invented in Chile, leading the way is the De Martino Estate in Miapo. Bright red berry fruit and a hint of spice, partially aged in oak to add structure and balance.

- <i>Mendoza</i> , Argentina	Sangiovese is the Tuscan grape of Chianti & there many similarities in this Argentinian interpretation. A delicious combination of sweet and savoury, ripe and spicy with some typical underlying dryness.

- <i>Mendoza</i> , Argentina	Rich, yet fruity with a nose of violets, figs and raisins with some underlying savoury notes of tobacco and dark chocolate. A long smooth finish with just enough grip from the soft tanins. The great beef wine!

- <i>Rioja</i> , Spain	Rioja is as popular as ever and this 'joven' or young style has no oak but plenty of rich berry fruit. Layers of damson and black fruits are intermixed with subtle spice, concentrated, yet soft & elegant on the finish.

- <i>Rhone</i> , France	Named after the famed wind (the Mistral) that blows through the Rhone valley to the Med this medium-bodied blend offers ripe red/dark fruit aromas and characteristic garrigue herbs and pepper notes				
Chianti dei Colli Senesi, Cantine Innocenti 2008				£24.00	
- <i>Tuscany</i> , Italy	Tuscany is a spellbindingly beautiful area and here the Sangiovese grape reigns supreme. This Chianti has flavours of spicy ripe cherries, roasted herbs, leather and liquorice with a grippy rustic finish.

- <i>Rhone</i> , France	From the juicy Gamay grape this classic cru Beaujolais has a dominant nose of strawberries, raspberries and ripe plums, supple on the palate but with sufficient weight and structure to carry it with food.				
Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Domaine Remoissenet 2007				£28.00	
- <i>Rhone</i> , France	This encapsulates the virtues of mature Pinot Noir, a fascinating bouquet of preserved berry fruits and, spice, good intensity on the palate with black fruits and a touch of game, firm yet elegant on the finish.				
Saint-Emillion, Chateau Cros Lamarzelle 2002				£33.00	
- <i>Rhone</i> , France	With a high proportion of Merlot there is a definite richness of fruit, which then gives way to more traditional 'Claret' characteristics. Notable aromas of cedar, pencil shavings and cassis with some 'forest floor'. Full and spicy on the palate with grippy tannins.				
Rioja Reserva, Hacienda Grimon 2005	(Organic)			£38.95	
- <i>Rioja</i> , Spain	Low yielding vines that give greater intensity of flavour & aged for 2 years in French & American oak. Aromas of black fruit with black pepper & spices, ripe tannins & fresh acidity sheathed in vanilla oak.				
Rosso di Montalcino, AA Pian Dell'Orino 2008	(Biodynamic)			£45.00	
- <i>Tuscany</i> , Italy	A simply delicious natural wine that offers the very best of pure Sangiovese. Warmth and richness and initial flavours of black cherry, cocoa and vanilla, there is an irresistible purity of fruit launched on the back of some bright acidity and finely calibrated tannins.

- <i>Rhone</i> , France	From a Domaine that can boast a 100 Parker point wine this classic blend expresses both fullness and finesse. Complex and delicious, think red fruit, herbs and spices, cocoa and fine grained tannins.
